Fedora is an operating system based on the Linux kernel, developed by the community-supported Fedora Project and sponsored by Red Hat.

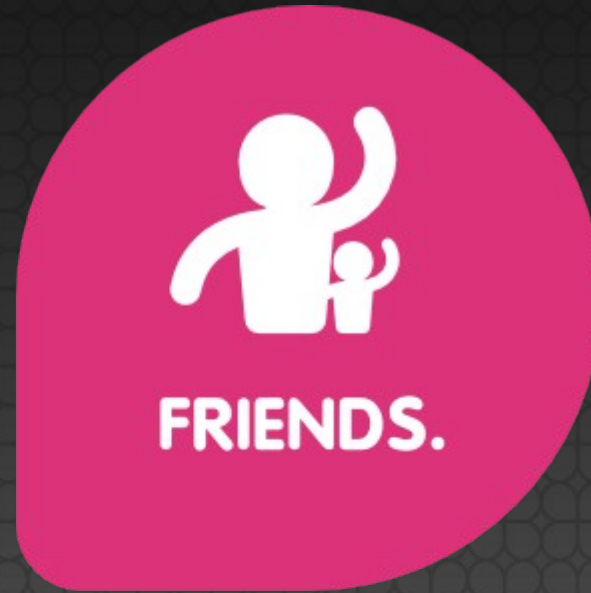

- Default user interface: GNOME

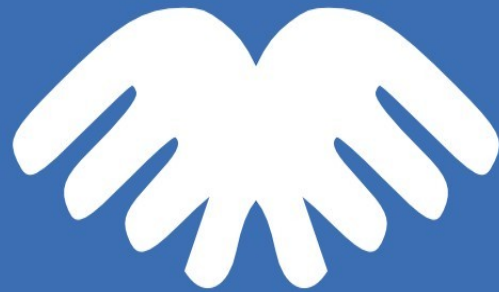
Mission

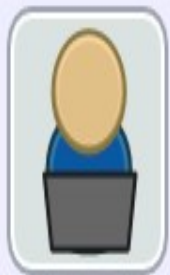
